



1 Height

If we know your approximate height and weight we can make sure your shirt will fit well based on our experience. We'll let you know if one of your measurements seems off to us.

2 Weight

3 Neck

Place the measuring tape around the base of your neck just below your adam's apple. The tape should be snug but not tight. We will add to your measurement to make sure your collar is not skin tight, so no need to pad your numbers.

4 Waist

Wrap the measuring tape around your stomach at the largest point. If **thin**, wrap the measuring tape just below your belly button. Please make sure the measuring tape is level.

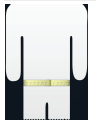

5 Shirt Length

At the back of a shirt, begin where the bottom of your collar attaches to the shirt body. Measure straight down to the center of the end of the shirt. Your shirt length measurement should end roughly at the bottom of your backside. Each shirt order allows you to choose a shorter length for an untucked shirt or a longer length that tucks in properly.

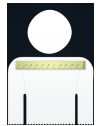

6 Chest

Wrap the measuring tape around the largest part of your chest. Please make sure the measuring tape is level.

7 Hips

Wrap the measuring tape around the largest part of your hips. Most often this will be midway down your backside.

8 Back

Find the end of your shoulder bone at the top of each shoulder by pressing lightly on the outside top of your shoulder. Measure between the two points across your back, following the natural curve of your back. The measuring tape should make a slight arch from one point to the other.

9 Arm Length

Find the end of your shoulder bone at the top of each shoulder by pressing lightly on the outside top of your shoulder. Measure from the end of your shoulder bone down along the outside of your elbow slightly angling the measuring tape to follow your forearm down to your wrist. Measure past your wrist and stop halfway between your wrist and the "v" made by your thumb and forefinger.

10 Right Wrist

Wrap the measuring tape just below where your hand meets your right wrist. If you wear a large watch on your right wrist, you can measure around your watch to make sure your cuff fits comfortably over your watch.

11 Left Wrist

Wrap the measuring tape just below where your hand meets your left wrist. If you wear a large watch on your left wrist, you can measure around your watch to make sure your cuff fits comfortably over your watch.
